## Objectives and investment policy

The Fund is actively managed with reference to the MSCI World (NR) EUR hedged Benchmark. The Fund promotes environmental, social and governance (ESG) characteristics (within the meaning of Article 8 of Regulation (EU) 2019/2088) through a combination of different portfolio management techniques. Details are available in the prospectus and the ESG website disclosure of the fund. The objective of the investment policy of Partners Group Listed Investment SICAV – Multi Asset Income ("sub-fund") is to achieve appropriate growth from capital growth and income in the currency of the share class while taking investment risk into consideration. The investment focus is on shares of companies with an attractive and sustainable dividend yield. The sub-fund invests at least two-thirds of its assets worldwide in listed shares, share certificates,

participation certificates, convertible bonds and bonds with warrants to shares, zero bonds and other funds. Focus is thereby placed on companies in the infrastructure, real estate and private equity sectors. The sub-fund may invest a maximum of 10% of its assets in other funds. For hedging purposes or to increase the assets, the sub-fund may also use financial instruments whose value depends on the future prices of other assets ("derivatives"). In principle, investors may redeem their shares on any banking day in Luxembourg, with the exception of 24 and 31 December. The redemption of shares may be suspended in extraordinary circumstances if this is deemed necessary in the interests of investors. The Fund reinvests but does not pay rewards to investors.

The Fund's risk and reward profile shows the variations in value an investment in this Fund would have undergone over the past five years, whereby simulated performance data is used in the case of missing history. ## Why is the Fund in the specific category?

Amongst other, equity prices mainly reflect the expected prospects of firms, as estimated by market participants. Expectations tend to fluctuate more strongly in times of higher uncertainty. Investments in bonds are affected by changes in interest rates, the size of the market segment, the currency allocation, the economic sector and the credit quality of the bonds. The Fund holds mainly investments with generally good credit quality. However, the Fund may be exposed to currency risk. The Fund may have a low degree of issuer diversification which makes it more vulnerable.

#### Are there any other particular risks?

The Fund's risk and reward profile does not reflect the risk inherent in future circumstances that differ from what the Fund has experienced in the recent past. This includes the following events which are rare but can have a large impact.

- Credit risk: Issuers of assets held by the Fund may not pay income or repay capital when due. The Fund's investments generally have low credit risk.
- Liquidity risk: Assets cannot necessarily be sold at limited cost in an adequately short timeframe. The Fund's investments may be prone to limited liquidity. The Fund will endeavor to mitigate this risk by various measures.
- Counterparty risk: Bankruptcy or insolvency of the Fund's derivative counterparties may lead to payment or delivery default. The Subfund will endeavor to mitigate this risk by the receipt of financial collateral given as guarantees.
- Operational risk: Deficient processes, technical failures or catastrophic events may cause losses.
- Political and Legal risks: Investments are exposed to changes of rules and standards applied by a specific country. This includes restrictions on currency convertibility, the imposing of taxes or controls on transactions, the limitations of property rights or other legal risks. Investments in less developed financial markets may expose the Fund to increased operational, legal and political risk.
- Sustainability risks: Sustainability risks are environmental, social or governance events or conditions that can have a material negative effect on the return, depending on the relevant sector, industry and company exposure.
